



# Rules of Conduct in a Local Recreation Area

All Ingolstadt citizens and those seeking recreation should feel at ease in a local recreation area.

There wouldn't be any problems if everyone would abide by the basic rules of conduct:

## Bathing and Swimming

- Refreshment needed? Simply enjoy the water, but please pay attention to the signs that may contain bans!
- In the event of danger, corresponding signs will indicate this.
- Please do not overestimate yourself! Please keep an eye on visitors less able than yourself.
- Bitte Please do not feed waterfowl and do not leave any food leftovers!



## Barbecues



- Barbecues are okay, but only in the specified areas. And please take your rubbish with you when you leave.
- Risk of forest fires! Therefore, no fires outside the barbecue area, or in the forest, park or public areas.
- A license is required for large-scale events.

## Alcohol and Cigarettes

- Drinking alcohol isn't a necessity! And please don't overdo it if you must.
- Please take empty bottles and caps with you, or dispose of them properly, when you leave.
- Please don't throw cigarette ends onto the floor and comply with the smoking bans.
- The risk of forest fires is particularly high during the summer months. Please don't smoke or light an open fire in the forest.



## Waste



- Please dispose of your waste in the rubbish bins. Or take it with you if the bins are already full!
- Cigarette ends harm the environment. They pose a particular risk for small children. Therefore, please dispose of them properly and don't simply throw them away.

## Music

- Loud music in public spaces should not disturb others. That also applies on the way home in the car.



## Dogs



- Ingolstadt is dog friendly: however, please take your dog's faeces with you. Disposal facilities are widely available.
- As a matter of principle, dogs should be kept on a leash. This is compulsory for dogs with a shoulder height of at least 50 cm.
- Dogs should only go in the water at the dog bathing beach.

## Cycling

- Do you travel by bike? The environment is grateful!
- Please take sunbathers into consideration or those en route between the water and sunbathing lawn.



## Vandalism



- Please leave the facilities and natural environment in a condition in which you would like to find them. Others want to benefit from them too.
- Vandalism is antisocial, costs a lot of money and is unnecessary.
- Please contact the police if you see something untoward. Property damage will be reported to the police.

## Night Owls and Camping

- Partying until late? Actually, it's not a problem as long as consideration is given to those wanting to sleep.
- The following rule applies: night-time rest is from 10.00 p.m. to 7.00 a.m.
- Staying overnight in a tent or camping are not permitted.
